

PIPE LINING SOLUTIONS

Have you been told you have to excavate or replace your drain or sewer pipe?

Z PLUMBERZ uses a process called **Cured in Place Pipe Lining (CIPP)** that enables us to repair nearly all types of piping while eliminating the need for digging and excavation.



Our Process

- 1. Have initial discussion with our plumber and the property manager or homeowner to understand the problem and set up inspection appointment
- 2. Inspect the pipe(s) using HD camera and video
- 3. "Prep" the pipe using high-powered air, vacuum and water tools (also known as "hydro jetting")
- 4. Evaluate the now-clean pipe(s) to determine if pipe lining is necessary
- 5. If pipe lining or coating IS needed, prep and measure the pipe for the liner / coating
- 6. Insert the CIPP liner to repair the damaged pipe
- 7. Leave CIPP Liner in place to cure
- 8. Wait for CIPP Liner to cure and return for final inspections and video
- 9. Enjoy your restored pipes!

Excavation	Required	None
Demolition & Restoration Impacts	Large trees and landscaping Streets, driveways, and sidewalks Concrete, pavers, and walkways Garages Pools and fountains Patios, porches, and decks	None - Property features, yards, streets, and landscaping are not impacted because we work within the existing infrastructure
Safety Concerns or Risks	Utility lines, underground wires, large equipment, excavation area/pit	Utilities are not impacted, no large equipment or excavation area; epoxy resins used are safe and have little-to-no odor
